Mission

The mission of the University Honors Program Peer Mentorship Program is to assist new students with the transition from high school to university life. The goal of the program is to integrate new students into the Honors Program and to support student success by increasing students' knowledge about the Honors Program, the University of Idaho, and campus and local resources.

Eligibility and Application Deadline

All Honors Program students who are first- or second-year students in the University Honors Program and are in good standing in the program are encouraged to apply by the annual deadline of **March 23**.

Benefits

- Peer mentors receive an annual scholarship of \$1,000 renewable until they graduate from the university. In order to have their scholarship renewed, peer mentors must meet the annual expectations listed below.
- This is a great leadership and service opportunity that focuses on interpersonal communication skills.

Expectations

Peer mentors apply in spring semesters and, if selected, commence their service the following fall. They are expected to:

- Attend the required occasional information and training meetings throughout the academic year.
- Commit to meeting with their mentee(s) at least once a month throughout the academic year.
- Assist with facilitating the program's college transition course HON INTR 104 "Academic Engagement" (or similar) on the days and times assigned to them.
- Commit to communicating with newly admitted or prospective Honors Program students.
- Meet the Honors Program GPA requirements.
