Building Corridor Use Exemption Request Form

Corridors and hallways must be kept clear of obstructions, regardless of exit width, to facilitate immediate, rapid exit from a building in the event of an emergency. Policies and procedures pertaining to building corridor and hallway use in university facilities may be found in the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM) Chapter 35, sections 23, 27 and 34.

In specific, temporary situations, this form may be used to submit requests to Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) for exceptions to this policy. EHS evaluates requests on a case-by-case basis and exemptions that are granted may be applied only to the specific situation(s), item(s) and location(s) noted on the completed form.

EHS will not approve exceptions for items that are combustible/flammable or may impede a rapid exit from the building or floor; block or restrict the visibility or access to exit doors or exit signs; or be placed in stairwells, no matter how temporary.

Unapproved items placed in corridors, hallways, or other paths of entry or egress are subject to immediate removal.
