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VERIFY YOUR COURSES ON THE SPRING 2025 SCHEDULE

The [Spring 2025 Schedule](#) linked here has been sent to teaching partners and Dual Credit contacts for review and confirmation. If the schedule correctly lists all your dual credit course offerings and teachers for your Spring Semester offerings, no further action is needed. **If any of your Dual Credit offerings are not listed, they are not currently scheduled. To ensure availability in DualEnroll, it is imperative that any additions or corrections be made no later than the end of the day Monday, Dec. 9.**

A few notes to be aware of as you review the schedule:

- **Yellow highlighted sections:** If applicable, indicates a course(s) that was offered during the Spring 2024 term but was not included on the scheduling survey, **or** no survey was received from your school, but the course(s) was offered during the Spring 2024 term. **Please contact Katie Riebold to confirm whether this course(s) will be offered in the upcoming Spring 2025 term.** If no response is received by the end of the day Monday, Dec. 9, the section(s) will be cancelled.

- **Green highlighted sections:** If applicable, indicates a course(s) that is being taught by a new Dual Credit teaching partner. The section will be scheduled once the teacher has completed their onboarding, **or** the scheduled section will be updated to include the teacher as the instructor of record once the final steps of onboarding are completed (account setup and FERPA training).
