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## WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE FOR FALL SEMESTER

The withdrawal deadline is **November 22** for Fall Semester and **February 7** for yearlong courses. All drop and withdrawal requests are processed through [DualEnroll](#) --requests must be submitted by the student and approved by the counselor prior to the posted deadline. DualEnroll must show a "Drop Complete" or "Withdrawal Complete" status and the student's and teaching partner's MyUI must also show a drop or withdrawal status to be complete. **MyUI is the official record!**

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### **Teacher Compensation \$20 per credit, per student**

**REMINDER:** University of Idaho Dual Credit and all SBOE-governed schools compensate high school teachers at the rate of \$20 per credit per student.

All Dual Credit programs statewide compensate teachers at the same rate of \$20 per credit per student. For a 3-credit course, then, a dual credit teacher would receive \$60 per student paid directly to them through the high school or as a direct affiliate.
