SUBJECT:	Moscow Campus Summer Construction and Street & Parking Lot Closures

With the end of the spring semester drawing near, construction projects are set to begin on the University of Idaho's Moscow campus in the coming weeks. Several of these projects are the result of the recent significant investment by the State of Idaho meant to address accumulated deferred maintenance issues. In addition, construction will commence for multiple projects funded by the university in advancement of strategic academic, research, and student life objectives.

On Monday, April 28th, the segment of Deakin Ave between Sweet Ave and University Ave will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic and a detour will be in place on College Ave and Railroad St. This project will address subgrade issues with the road, widen sidewalks, and upgrade aging utility infrastructure.

Following Spring Commencement, construction will begin on three projects in the undergraduate residential neighborhood. Improvements to the Wallace Residence Center Stevenson Wing, improvements to Theophilus Tower, and repairs and improvements to Paradise Creek Street will all **begin on Monday, May 12**th. Paradise Creek Street from Line Street to the Wallace Residence Center, along with Parking Lots 5, 25, and 108, will be closed until the beginning of August.

These closures can be viewed on the <u>Summer 2025 Parking Map</u>.

Additional new construction projects and ongoing construction activities planned for summer of 2025 include, but are not limited to:

- Continued construction of the South Hill Graduate and Family Housing Improvements.
- The addition to the Huckabay Medical Education building on Sweet Avenue.
- The new Meat Science and Innovation Center building on Perimeter Drive.
- Renovations to select floors in: Theophilus Tower and Wallace Residence Center.
- Repairs and improvements to the elevators in: Janssen Engineering Building, Lionel Hampton School of Music Building, and Art & Architecture North and South.

- Installation of a new elevator at the Hartung Theater.
- HVAC improvements efforts at: Iddings Agricultural Sciences Laboratory, Buchannan Engineering Laboratory, P1FCU Kibbie Dome, Life Sciences South, and Lionel Hampton School of Music Building.
- Window replacements at: Art & Architecture, Mary E. Forney Hall, Hays Hall, Renfrew Hall, Student Recreation Center
- Roof repairs at: Mary E. Forney Hall, Hays Hall
- Exterior repairs at: ISUB, Janssen Engineering Building, College of Mines, Mary E. Forney Hall, Hays Hall, Renfrew Hall, and Ridenbaugh Hall.
- Replacement of the Chiller and Life Safety Generator at College of Natural Resources.
- Concourse leveling at the P1FCU Kibbie Dome.
- Deferred maintenance to various campus wayfinding signage.
