



January Day Camp Information

Winter STEM: In this class we will design the biggest snowman out of marshmallows, create a snow removal device, make a snowstorm in a jar, design a bristle bot and more.

Owl and Raptor: Fish and wildlife will be here to teach about raptors and owls and about how they survive in the winter. We will also be dissecting owl pellets.

Sweet Bread (Baking 2): We will be learning measurements, mixing and reading recipes as we make lemon bread, pumpkin bread, banana bread, and cinnamon swirl bread.

Bracelet Making: Learn to make a daisy chain bracelet.

Cookie Craze: We will be making a lot of different kinds of cookies such as different kinds of chocolate chip cookies, oatmeal cookies, brownie cookies, peanut butter cookies, sugar cookies, doodle cookies, and no bake cookies.

Wood Burning: For this class you need to be at least 10 years old. Come learn the technique of wood burning as you use a wood burner to create a piece of art.

Sourdough Bread: Come learn about sourdough starter, how to feed it and take care of it, and how to bake an Artisan loaf of sourdough bread.

Cloverbuds (for 5–8-year-olds): This month our theme is hibernation and the winter blues. Some of the things that we will cover:

Hibernation, why animals hibernate, what keeps them warm, the winter blues and how we can we help ourselves feel better when we are sad.
