Whimsical Bird House

You can build a birdhouse, create a stand for it, and paint it whatever color(s) you want. The bottom has a plant holder that can hold real or fake flowers or bird seed.

Food Art

You will cook and create five different animal-inspired meals and snacks.

Garden Club Step 1: The Seed

You will learn about seeds, how they grow, and the best way to plant them. The seeds will be planted indoors to get ready for spring planting outside.

This club will continue through the summer for those interested.

Flower Vase Frog

You will use clay to create a frog and then paint it the next day. The frog is a vase topper to put flowers through to create a unique arrangement. The frog is reusable.

You will create a wood sign that can be used to decorate your home. You will learn painting skills and how to use vinyl.

Apron

You will learn basic sewing skills and make an apron. The second day is for those who don't finish during the first class.

Acrylic Glass Painting

You will finger paint with acrylic paint on glass.
