FOR LATAH COUNTY LANDSCAPES

Latah County Master Gardener's Recommend...

Tartarian Maple | *Acer tataricum*

Wide range, small tree or large shrub

Saskatoon Serviceberry | *Amelanchier alnifolia*

Native, well-drained

Pagoda Dogwood | *Cornus alternifolia*

Moist, well drained, shady, fruit, colorful flowers

Eastern Wahoo | *Euonymus atropurpureus*

Adapted to harsh conditions, red flowers, fall color

Sargeant Crabapple | *Malus sargentii*

Spring flowering, fall fruit.

Washington Hawthorne | *Crataegus phaenopyrum*

Tolerates compacted soil, fall colors, berries

Japanese Tree Lilac | *Syringa reticulata*

Adapts to various soil conditions

Arborvitae | *Thuja occidentalis*

Windbreak, soft greens, conifer, a variety of sizes

Nannyberry Viburnum | *Viburnum lentago*

Wide soil conditions

Mugo Pine | *Pinus mugo*

Moist well drained soils, dwarf tree
