- **Spring enrollment**. We are up 2.8% compared to this time last spring.
- Brief update on state legislature (Provost Lawrence). The Governor's state of the state address laid out some priorities. K-12 education was a major focus in the speech. We watch for main topics such as: our budgets and Gen. Ed. funding for the U of I; DEI; the University of Phoenix; medical training and healthcare programs in the state.
- Strategic Planning Committee Update. Barb Kirchmeier, senate representative on the
 committee, gave a brief update on their progress. They continue to work with Heron, university
 partners in this endeavor, and their plans are on schedule. More information can be found in
