

## Faculty Senate Talking Points, March 4, 2025, Meeting #25

- Information on employee's **CEC** (Change in Employee Compensation) is not yet available from the Legislature. The Provost will communicate updates as they become available.
- Faculty Affairs Committee approved the creation of a Faculty Compensation Committee. The
  Committee on Committees will be tasked with working out the structure and charge of the new
  committee to be presented to Faculty Senate.
- Faculty Senate Leadership is seeking a volunteer senate member to sit on the **Benefits Advisory Committee**. If interested, please email Kristin at <a href="mailto:khaltinner@uidaho.edu">khaltinner@uidaho.edu</a>.
- Changes to FSH 3780 Dependent Educational Tuition and Fee Reduction were approved by Faculty Senate. These changes include a 25% discount on tuition for a second eligible dependent. The first eligible dependent will continue to receive the 50% reduction.
- Dean of COGS Jerry McMurtry and Provost Lawrence spoke about potential impacts of **federal grant modifications** on UI. At this point, no changes are being implemented by the university.
