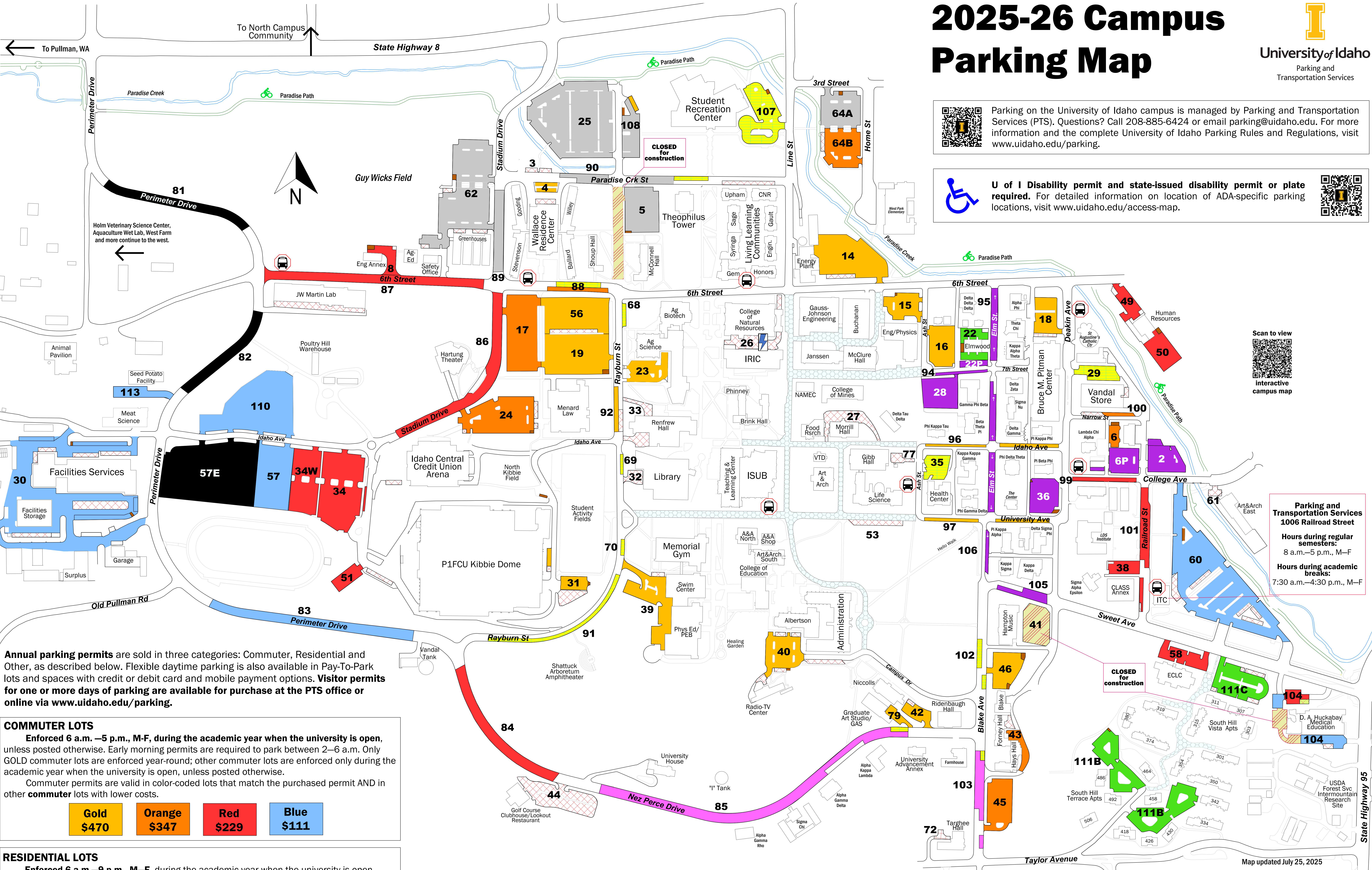

Annual parking permits are sold in three categories: Commuter, Residential and Other, as described below. Flexible daytime parking is also available in Pay-To-Park lots and spaces with credit or debit card and mobile payment options. **Visitor permits for one or more days of parking are available for purchase at the PTS office or online via www.uidaho.edu/parking.**

COMMUTER LOTS
Enforced 6 a.m. –5 p.m., M-F, during the academic year when the university is open, unless posted otherwise. Early morning permits are required to park between 2–6 a.m. Only GOLD commuter lots are enforced year-round; other commuter lots are enforced only during the academic year when the university is open, unless posted otherwise.

Commuter permits are valid in color-coded lots that match the purchased permit AND in other **commuter** lots with lower costs.

RESIDENTIAL LOTS
Enforced 6 a.m.–9 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open, unless posted otherwise. Overnight parking is allowed. No parking on streets 2–6 a.m. during summer and academic breaks. Green lots are enforced year-round.


SMART Transit FREE bus service: No car? NO PROBLEM!

OTHER LOT TYPES AND PARKING INFORMATION




PAY-TO-PARK AREAS: Credit or debit card and/or mobile pay options available. Enforced 6 a.m.–9 p.m., M–F, year-round, unless posted otherwise. No overnight parking.




MANAGED AREAS: Special permit required; includes but is not limited to ADA Accessible, Reserved, Service and Delivery parking. Contact PTS at 208-885-6424 for more information.




MOTORCYCLE SPACES: Daytime motorcycle parking, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. only. Overnight motorcycle parking is valid **ONLY** in Silver 108 and Blue 60. No permit required.



ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS: There are two EV charging stations located in Lot 26. These metered spaces require payment while charging.



CAMPUS WALKWAY SYSTEM: Restricted vehicle access and parking. Parking only in designated spaces with special permit is required at all times. No overnight parking.



BICYCLE PATH: Paradise Path and connected bicycle trails.
