
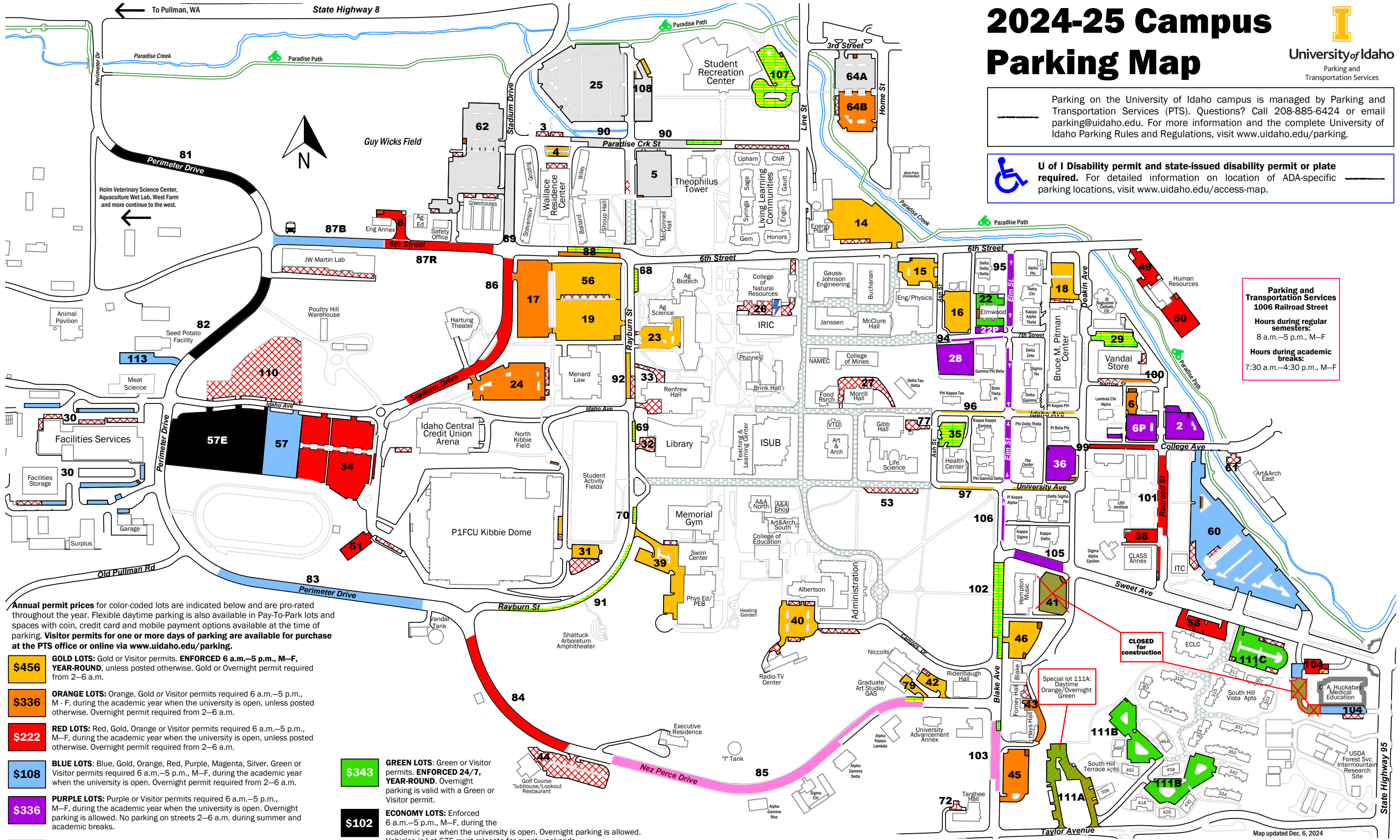


2024-25 Campus Parking Map





Annual permit prices for color-coded lots are indicated below and are pro-rated throughout the year. Flexible daytime parking is also available in Pay-To-Park lots and spaces with coin, credit card and mobile payment options available at the time of parking. **Visitor permits for one or more days of parking are available for purchase at the PTS office or online via www.uidaho.edu/parking.**

- \$456** **GOLD LOTS:** Gold or Visitor permits. **ENFORCED 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, YEAR-ROUND**, unless posted otherwise. Gold or Overnight permit required from 2–6 a.m.
- \$336** **ORANGE LOTS:** Orange, Gold or Visitor permits required 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open, unless posted otherwise. Overnight permit required from 2–6 a.m.
- \$222** **RED LOTS:** Red, Gold, Orange or Visitor permits required 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open, unless posted otherwise. Overnight permit required from 2–6 a.m.
- \$108** **BLUE LOTS:** Blue, Gold, Orange, Red, Purple, Magenta, Silver, Green or Visitor permits required 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open. Overnight permit required from 2–6 a.m.
- \$336** **PURPLE LOTS:** Purple or Visitor permits required 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open. Overnight parking is allowed. No parking on streets 2–6 a.m. during summer and academic breaks.
- \$336** **MAGENTA LOTS:** Magenta or Visitor permits required 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open. Overnight parking is allowed. No parking on streets 2–6 a.m. during summer and academic breaks.
- \$336** **SILVER LOTS:** Silver or Visitor permits required 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open. Overnight parking is allowed. No parking on streets 2–6 a.m. during summer & academic breaks.

- \$343** **GREEN LOTS:** Green or Visitor permits. **ENFORCED 24/7, YEAR-ROUND.** Overnight parking is valid with a Green or Visitor permit.
- \$102** **ECONOMY LOTS:** Enforced 6 a.m.–5 p.m., M–F, during the academic year when the university is open. Overnight parking is allowed. Vehicles in Lot 57E must relocate for event weekends.
-  **PAY-TO-PARK AREAS:** Coin, credit card and/or mobile pay options available. Enforced 6 a.m.–9 p.m., M–F, year-round, unless posted otherwise. No overnight parking.
-  **MANAGED AREAS:** Special permit required; includes but is not limited to ADA Accessible, Reserved, Service and Delivery parking. Contact PTS at 208-885-6424 for more information.

-  **PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY:** Restricted vehicle access and parking. Parking only in designated spaces with special permit is required at all times. No overnight parking.
-  **SMART TRANSIT BUS STOPS:** There are eight SMART Transit stops located on campus. SMART Transit fixed-route buses are FREE for students and the entire Moscow community. Visit www.smarttransit.org for more information.

-  **MOTORCYCLE SPACES:** Motorcycle parking only. No permit required.
-  **BICYCLE PATH:** Paradise Path and connected bicycle trails.
-  **ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS:** There are two EV charging stations located in Lot 26. These metered spaces require payment while charging.
